MEET THE DECISION MAKERS

During the Business Briefing, you and your company will have the opportunity to receive the latest information on Iraq's Civil Aviation sector requirements and to discuss your products in one-on-one meetings with twelve (12) senior officials from the Iraqi Ministry of Transportation, Civil Aviation Authority, Regional Airports and Iraqi Airways, who are directly responsible for the development of the country's reconstruction projects and the allocation of internal resources. This delegation will be led by Iraq's Minister of Transportation.

Iraq's three major airports, Baghdad, Basrah, and Mosul, are being rehabilitated and provincial governments are upgrading the airports in Erbil, Sulamaniyah and Najaf. Procurement has already started for investments in utility and infrastructure systems; reestablishment of air traffic control systems; and the procurement of baggage handling and passenger ticketing equipment. Despite a challenging reconstruction environment and a deteriorated Iraqi civil aviation system, significant progress has already been achieved.
