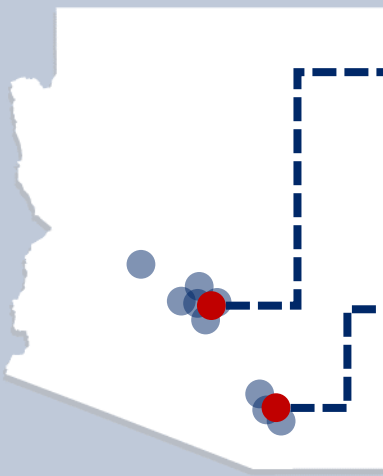

☀️ As a result of a USTDA-funded grant, **First Solar (Tempe, AZ)**, gained the opportunity to supply the generation equipment, engineering, procurement, and construction services for a 100 MW solar plant in Ma'an, Jordan. According to the USTDA grantee, Kavar Energy, First Solar offered the most reliable solutions in hot weather conditions and performed the best during peak demand, as compared to other competitors.

🏗️ USTDA funded a technical assistance program in Kenya that has helped fast track the development of geothermal resources in the country using equipment and services sourced from a **Tucson-based** supplier and eight additional U.S. firms.
