As a result of a USTDA feasibility study, Essar Oil Limited, an private oil and gas company in India, purchased technology licenses from a **Wilmington-based company to expand and modernize a refinery in Vadinar, India.**

Because of a USTDA reverse trade mission, another **Wilmington-based supplier sold solar panels to Kenya, increasing cell phone charging capabilities, ultimately increasing communication efficiency and expanding electricity access in the country.**
