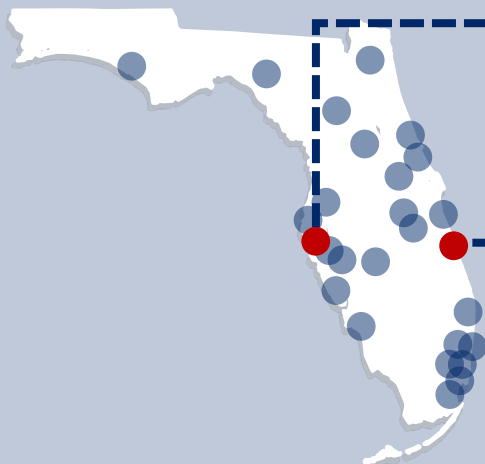

 Following USTDA-funded technical assistance to Colombia's National Directorate of Taxes and Customs, **L-3 Security Detection Systems (St. Petersburg, FL)** sold x-ray systems to two ports in Colombia to improve security at ports of entry and facilitate trade.

 After the USTDA-sponsored 2015 U.S.-India Aviation Partnership Summit, **Harris Corporation (Melbourne, FL)** secured a 15 year contract with the Airports Authority of India to modernize India's Air Traffic Communications Infrastructure.
