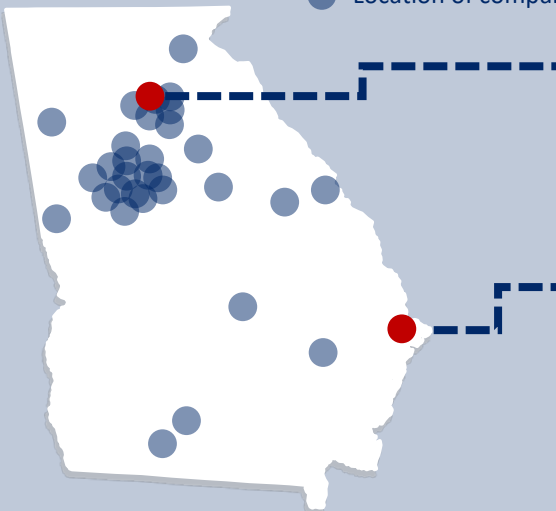

Through a USTDA-funded feasibility study, **Landis+Gyr (Alpharetta, GA)** exported smart grid technology to improve Brazil's electric power distribution networks.

As a result of USTDA-funded technical assistance grant for Azerbaijan's State Civil Aviation Administration, **Gulfstream (Savannah, GA)** was selected to provide aircraft for flights from Azerbaijan to the United States.
