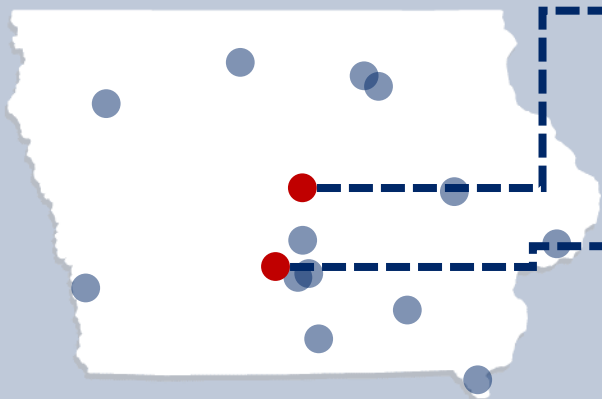

 As a result of relationships formed at a USTDA symposium, a Mexican entity purchased road construction equipment from a U.S. manufacturer based in **Ames, IA**. The equipment has improved road conditions in Mexico and facilitated better traffic flow in the country.

 Because of connections made through a USTDA-funded reverse trade mission, a manufacturer from **Urbandale, IA** sold extruders to private soybean processing companies in Malawi and Ghana to help enhance agricultural productivity.
