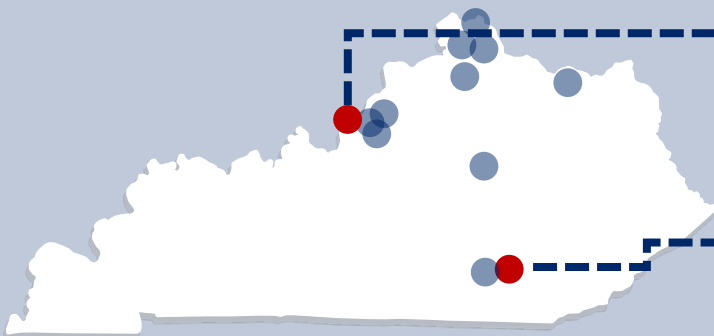

 As a result of USTDA-funded technical assistance in India, **ISCO Industries (Louisville, KY)** exported HDPE pipes to develop coal bed methane resources in the Sohagpur coal fields in northern India.
