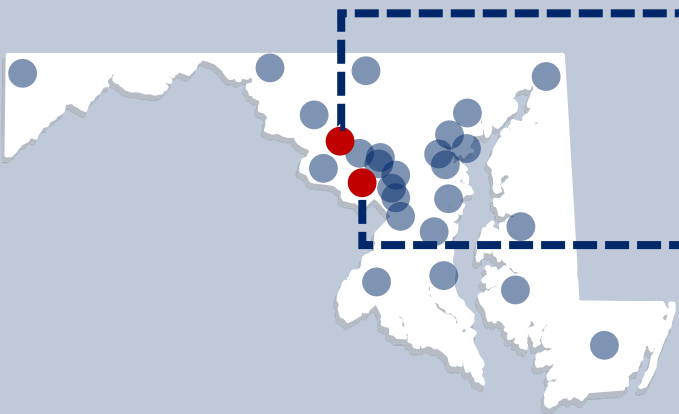

Following its participation in the USTDA-funded Nereidas Valley Geothermal Power Plant Feasibility Study in Colombia, **Dewhurst Group, LLC (Germantown, MD)** was selected to continue providing technical expertise on geothermal power plant development across Latin America.
