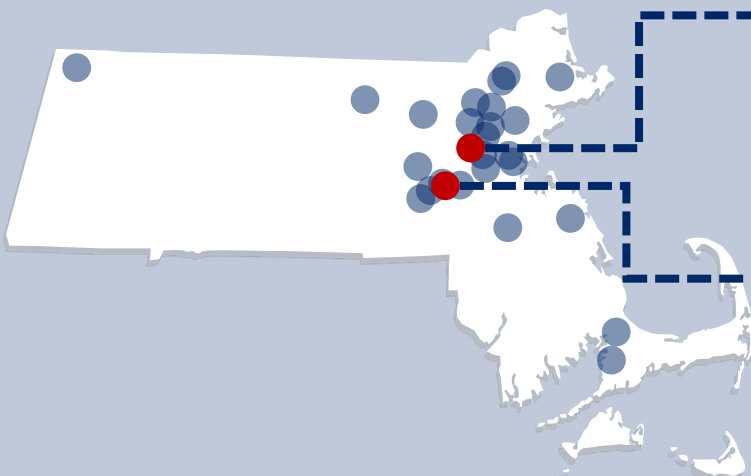

 USTDA hosted a workshop in Mexico City to promote U.S.-Mexico partnerships in infrastructure. Seven U.S. companies attributed new exports to this workshop, including a business in **Bedford** which sold security inspection equipment to an airport operator in Mexico.

 USTDA-funded technical assistance enabled Haiti to meet its urgent need for reliable power and expanded energy access using rehabilitation services from a **Framingham**-based construction firm, supporting five electrical substations.
