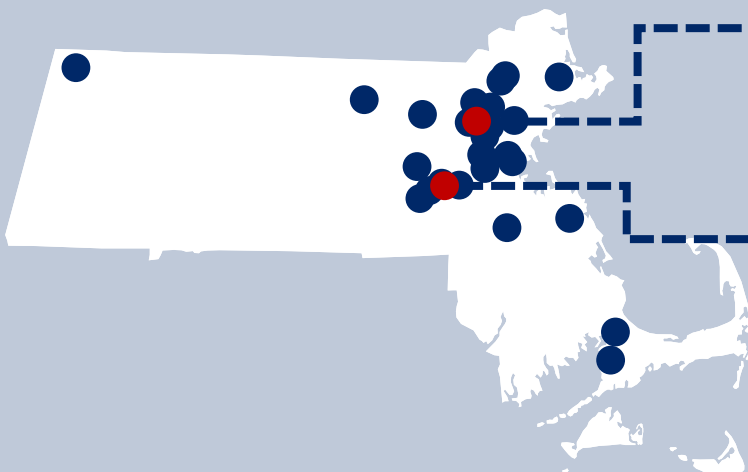

## PROVEN RESULTS FOR MASSACHUSETTS BUSINESSES

 USTDA hosted a workshop in Mexico City to promote U.S.-Mexico partnerships in infrastructure. Seven U.S. companies attributed new exports to this workshop including **Reveal Imaging Systems (Bedford, MA)**, which was able to sell security inspection equipment to Mexican airport operator Grupo Aeroportuario Centro Norte.

 USTDA funded technical assistance for Electricité d'Haiti (EdH), Haiti's state-owned electric utility company. The project helped Haiti meet its urgent need for reliable power and expanded energy access. At the same time, the project produced over \$13 million in U.S. exports, including rehabilitation services for five electrical substations from **Perini Management Services (Framingham, MA)**.
