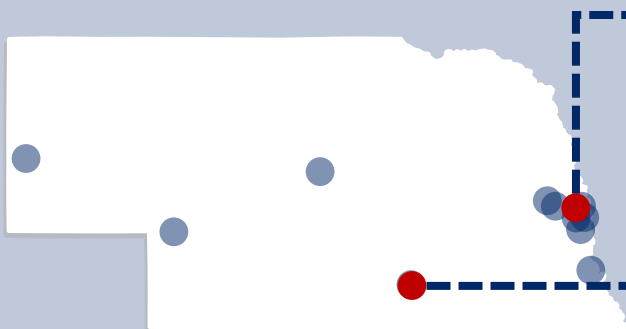

 Following USTDA-funded technical assistance that helped a Colombian port obtain recognition as compliant with the U.S. Container Security Initiative, a firm in **Omaha, NE** won a contract to supply cranes, hoists, and monorails for port improvement projects in Colombia.

 As a result of a USTDA-funded reverse trade mission for agribusiness sector representatives from Sub-Saharan Africa, a business based in **Hastings, NE** exported irrigation equipment—all of which was manufactured in Nebraska—to the region.
