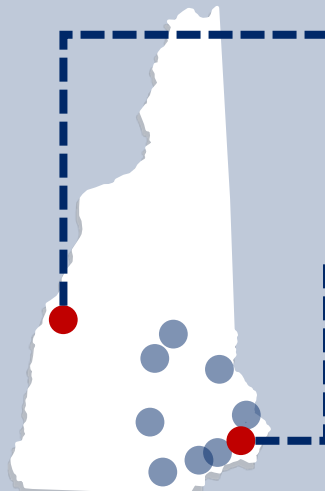

⚡ Following a USTDA-funded reverse trade mission that introduced Vietnam energy sector officials to U.S. standards for dam and plant construction, **Geokon, Inc. (Lebanon, NH)** sold geotechnical instruments to support hydropower projects in Vietnam.

🔧 After USTDA funded a feasibility study for the implementation of a Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition and Distribution Automation (SCADA) System for a part of the Philippines' power transmission and distribution system, **H&L Instruments, L.L.C. (North Hampton, NH)** was selected to provide fiber optic components for the improved system.
