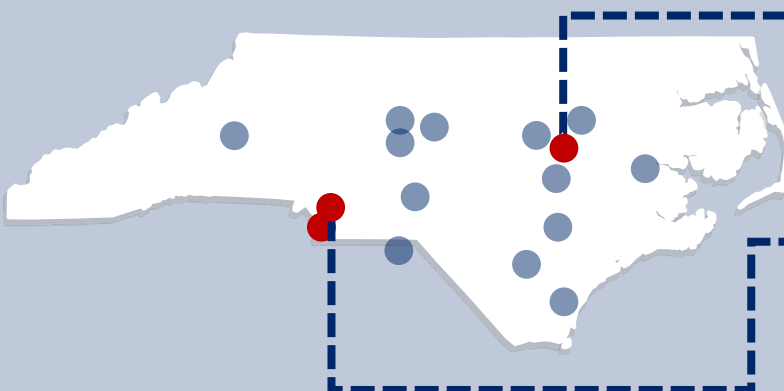

Following a USTDA-funded reverse trade mission that brought Latin American energy sector decision-makers to the United States to learn about U.S. smart grid technologies and equipment, **Elster Solutions, LLC (Raleigh, NC)** was selected to sell electricity meters to the Federal Electricity Commission in Mexico.

After officials from Colombia's petroleum refining sector participated in a USTDA-funded reverse trade mission, they selected **SPX Corporation, Inc. (Charlotte, NC)** and **Controls Southeast Inc. (Pineville, NC)** to provide thermal technologies for the Colombia Cartagena Refinery.
