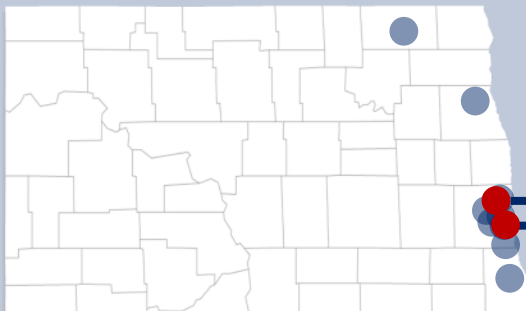

✈ USTDA sponsored a reverse trade mission with delegates from Botswana, Kenya, South Africa, and Zambia to visit U.S. equipment manufacturers and agricultural production sites in several states, including North Dakota. As a result of the reverse trade mission, three firms in the **Fargo, ND** area gained new customers from Sub-Saharan Africa through new exports of agricultural machinery.

🏠 A USTDA-funded feasibility study examined the expansion and modernization of the Port of Cortés in Honduras. As a result of this study, 15 skid steer loaders were procured from a manufacturer in **Fargo, ND** to develop dry bulk unloading infrastructure at the port.
