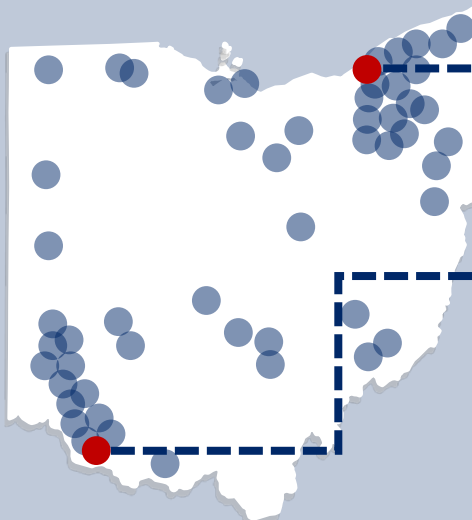

### PROVEN RESULTS FOR OHIO BUSINESSES

As a result of a USTDA-funded reverse trade mission, **PLIDCO (Westlake, OH)** exported pipe repair products to Iraq to improve the operations and efficiency of Iraq's oil and gas infrastructure.



Following two USTDA grant-funded feasibility studies, **Landrum & Brown (Cincinnati, OH)** exported airport master planning services to Colombia and South Africa to support expansion and modernization of airports in both countries.
