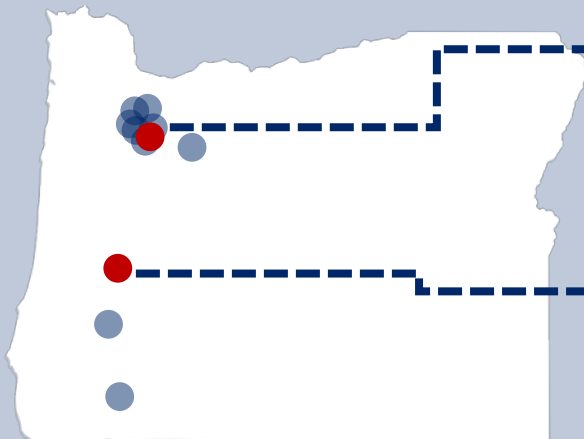

⚡ Through a USTDA-funded technical assistance, **FLIR Systems (Wilsonville, OR)** was identified as a potential supplier of sulfur hexafluoride-detecting cameras. As a result, FLIR sold Mexico's Federal Electricity Commission 12 of these cameras, enabling the country's power plants to comply with local environmental regulations.

🌱 As a result of a USTDA-funded feasibility study, **Milestone Systems, Inc. (Beaverton, OR)** won a contract with Buenaventura Regional Port Authority in Colombia to provide server software to store closed-circuit television footage and improve port security.
