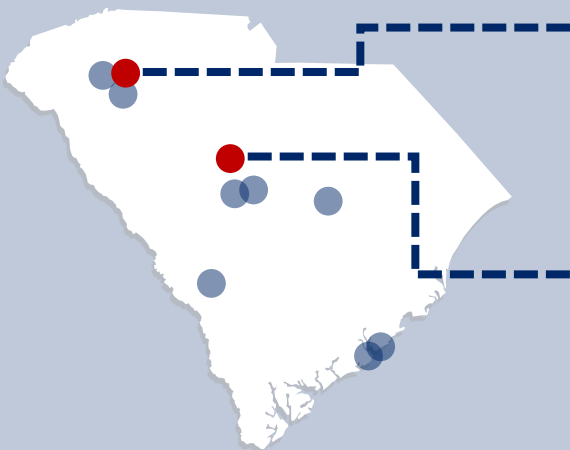

A USTDA-funded training grant to Sonelgez, Algeria's national electricity company, led to the procurement of U.S. power generation equipment, including gas and steam turbines manufactured at **General Electric's Greenville, SC** plant, to power eight million Algerian households.



As a result of participation in a USTDA reverse trade mission, **CDM Smith (Columbia, SC)** won highway construction and consulting services contracts in Vietnam, helping increase capacity and reduce transit times.
