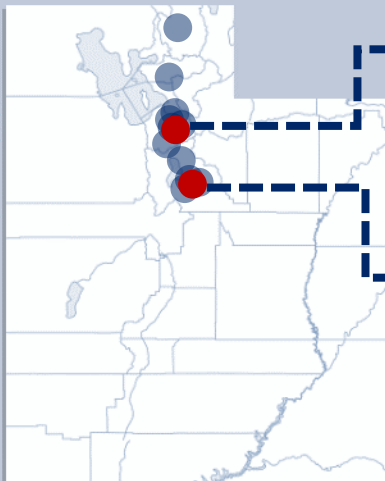

### PROVEN RESULTS FOR UTAH BUSINESSES

 USTDA hosted a reverse trade mission for representatives from the Philippine water sector, which led to a business in **Salt Lake City, UT** exporting wastewater technology for the construction of wastewater treatment plants to improve water quality in Manila Bay.

 A USTDA technical assistance project laid the groundwork for Unidad Corporativa Minera to develop the Pueblo Viejo mine in the Dominican Republic. The mine, which began commercial production in 2013, was constructed using equipment from over 20 U.S. suppliers including firms in **Provo** and **Wood Cross, UT**.
