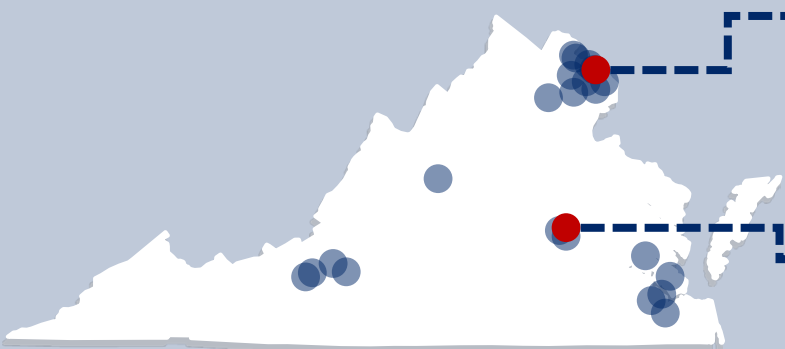

🏗️ Recommendations from USTDA-funded technical assistance supported the development of multiple electrification projects in Haiti following a devastating 2010 earthquake. These projects generated almost \$19 million in U.S. exports, including the distribution equipment and services from **NRECA International (Arlington, VA)**.

☀️ USTDA funded technical assistance for the Morocco Agency for Solar Energy (MASEN) to support the development of a 150-megawatt solar power project. Construction began in 2016 and, utilizing cooling systems exported from **Alfa Laval, Inc. (Richmond, VA)**, the project began commercial operations in 2018.
