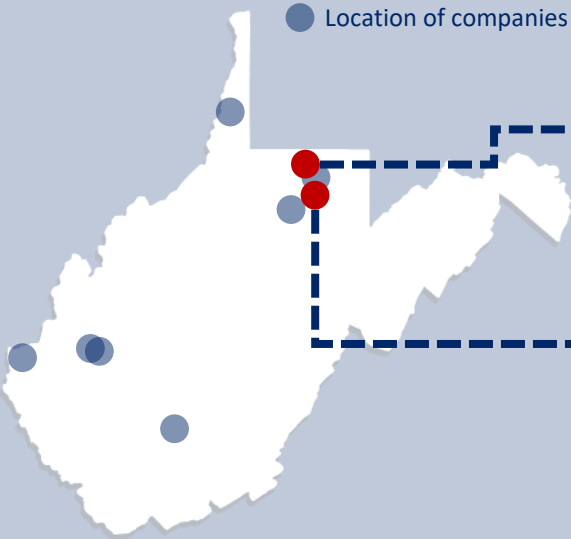

 As a result of a USTDA-funded grant, a research center in **Morgantown, WV** was chosen to provide decision makers in Mexico with data to help implement institutional, regulatory and market reforms to reduce transportation pollution in Mexico City.

 Senior coal industry officials from Indonesia, Vietnam, and India visited a coal-fired power plant in **Morgantown** as part of a USTDA-funded reverse trade mission to learn about coal-fired power emissions monitoring and control technologies.
