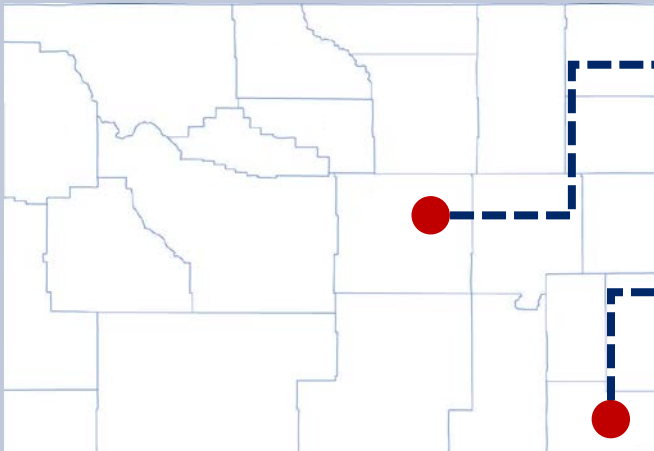

PROVEN RESULTS FOR WYOMING BUSINESSES



 A USTDA-funded feasibility study laid the groundwork for Trinidad's LNG upstream production and delivery system. Over 140 U.S. companies, including a business based in **Casper, WY**, participated in the project's implementation.
