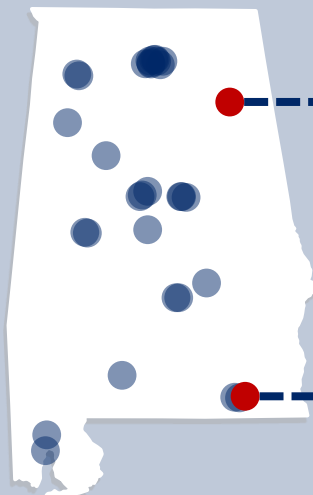

 Following a USTDA-funded reverse trade mission highlighting U.S. railway integration and locomotive refurbishment technologies, **Progress Rail Services (Albertville, AL)** won a contract to supply electro-diesel locomotives and associated parts and services to several Brazilian rail concessionaires.

 USTDA-funded technical assistance enabled Indonesia's meteorology and geophysics agency to develop a disaster management plan and technology strategy, which led to the purchase of 14 C-band weather radar systems from a business in **Enterprise, AL**.
