

AMENDMENT #1: USTDA ACTIVITY NO. 2020-11025A NIGERIA: DARWAY COAST ENERGY ACCESS PROJECT

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Please note that the Request for Proposals (RFP) for the FEASIBILITY STUDY for the Nigeria: Darway Coast Energy Access Project is amended, as follows:

Questions, Answers and Clarifications: This amendment consists of clarifying questions and answers submitted by potential Offerors regarding the RFP packet. Responses to submitted questions are below.

**Question:** On page 47 of 81, Task 2: Site Screening and Selection, for the 13 points regarding the acquisition of datasets for site screening and assessment, it states that the Grantee will assist with the acquisition of same. Additionally, on page 48 of 81, Task 2: Site Screening and Selection, it states that the Contractor shall incorporate the information gleaned from the above acquired datasets into a “Project Area GIS” for the application of a screening and analysis criteria. Is there a cost attributable to this and, if yes, will the Contractor and or the Grantee bear this cost?

**Answer:** The expectation is that both the contractor and the grantee will provide staff, with each bearing the cost of their own staff for site screening and assessment. Regarding the acquisition of datasets, there may be some datasets that the Contractor would decide to procure if they seemed particularly helpful. However, the expectation is that the Contractor will be responsible for creating the “Project Area GIS” and will bring more powerful and specialized softwares for site screening/assessment such as Fraym, HOMER, Odyssey etc. (the Grantee currently uses google maps).
