After completing a USTDA aviation feasibility study, T.Y. Lin International (San Francisco, CA) (TYLI) was well-positioned to compete for — and win — subsequent engineering contracts in Colombia. Their work under the USTDA grant allowed them the opportunity to access and thrive in a high growth market. TYLI has since opened its first office in Colombia and hired additional staff in the United States to support its expansion. SSL (Palo Alto, CA) won a competitive bid to supply a commercial

satellite to Azerbaijan's state-owned satellite company, Azercosmos, following the completion of a USTDA-funded study which confirmed the technical and financial viability of the Azerbaijani government's proposed investment. The "Azerspace-2" satellite was successfully launched in September 2018.
