

AMENDMENT #1: 2020-51009A Energisa Metering Master Plan

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Please note that the Request for Proposals (RFP) for the Technical Assistance for the Energisa Metering Master Plan is amended, as follows:

Questions, Answers and Clarifications: This amendment consists of clarifying questions and answers submitted by potential Offerors regarding the RFP packet. Responses to submitted questions are attached.

RFP Amendment

Q1: Do all report deliverables need to be submitted in both English and Portuguese?

A1: As stated in the Terms of Reference, "All deliverables shall be submitted in English with the exception of the Final Report that shall be submitted in both English and Portuguese."

Q2: Will the scope of work require any travel from the U.S. to Brazil?

A2: As stated in the Terms of Reference, "Any meetings or other actions or work set forth under these Terms of Reference that are indicated to occur in-person, on-site or otherwise in a specified location may, if agreed by both the Client and the Contractor (and with advance notice to and written agreement from USTDA), be conducted remotely, including online, by teleconference, by videoconference, or by other means, provided that the Contractor shall clearly document in the corresponding deliverable report the date on which such agreement was reached and approved by USTDA, and shall describe the alternative means of accomplishing the relevant work, along with the rationale for such decision."

Q3: Will the project team for the Technical Assistance be precluded from bidding on future potential work related to the project?

A3: Per the Grantee, the selected firm and the consultants who work on the Technical Assistance will not be precluded from bidding on future potential work related to the project.

Q4: Is there any existing Business/Operational Intelligence/Analytics data that would be applicable for this Project available?

A4: Yes, Task 1 in the Terms of Reference includes an information review where the Grantee shall provide to the Contractor all available information relevant to the Technical Assistance.

Q5: Is a meeting with the Regulatory Agency personnel, ANEEL, desirable to ensure that regulatory framework impact is adequately addressed in the Project?

A5: As stated in Task 3 in the Terms of Reference, "The Client shall provide guidance and input from its staff that manages regulatory issues to assist the Contractor in conducting this regulatory review."

Q6: For the four business cases, will ENERGISA provide applicable field results and/or benefit data from prior AMI trials, if available?

A6: Task 1 in the Terms of Reference includes an information review where the Grantee shall provide to the Contractor all available information relevant to the Technical Assistance.
