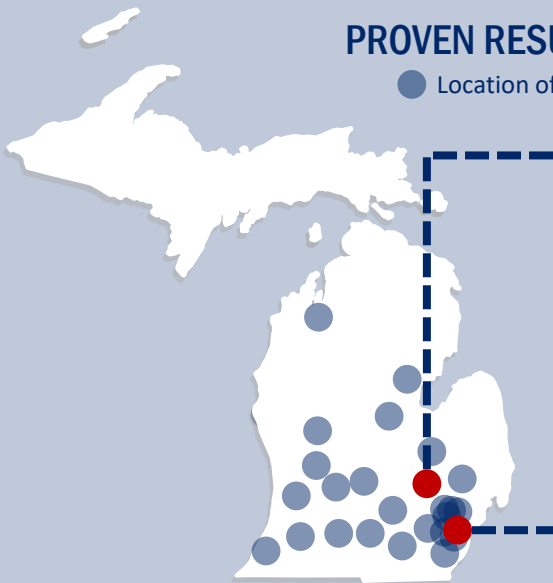

A USTDA-funded reverse trade mission brought over 30 officials from Romania's railway sector to the United States to meet with U.S. rail companies. Due to connections made on the visit, a manufacturer from **Flint, MI** sold locomotives to a Romanian railway carrier, helping expand rail access throughout the country.

As a result of a USTDA feasibility study, a power utility in Namibia purchased boiler equipment from a manufacturer based in **Monroe, MI** for the rehabilitation of a coal-fired power plant to help extend the plant's life by a decade.
