## U.S.-Southeast Asia ACP Aircraft and Avionics Workshop

This USTDA-funded virtual workshop will bring together government officials and industry experts to discuss new technologies and maintenance requirements for aircraft and avionics. Attendees will hear directly from U.S. government officials and industry about best practices for connecting with U.S. aviation companies to address local aviation needs and enable effective and safe national air transportation systems. This will be the fourth event hosted under the Southeast Asia Aviation Workshop Series, which includes a total of six technical workshops designed to promote aviation cooperation between the public and private sectors in the U.S. and Southeast Asia.

### BACKGROUND

The Southeast Asia Aviation Cooperation Program is a public-private partnership that works with aviation stakeholders in Southeast Asia to design programs that promote technical, policy and commercial cooperation in civil aviation. SEA ACP is industry led and government supported with cooperation from the U.S. Trade and Development Agency, Federal Aviation Administration, U.S. Department of Transportation, Transportation Security Administration and U.S. Department of Commerce.

The SEA ACP:

- Provides a cooperative framework for government interaction between Southeast Asian countries and U.S. government partners
- Promotes a safe and secure airspace through training on international standards and aviation best practices
- Enables Southeast Asian governments and local industry to engage directly with U.S. companies to learn best practices and gain critical aviation expertise

Program activities match the needs of Southeast Asian countries with the technical innovation of U.S. member companies. Activities include workshops, training, technical assistance, symposia and reverse trade missions.
