## Uncrewed Aircraft System (UAS) Delivery Technologies Workshop for the Pacific

The U.S. Trade and Development Agency (USTDA) will host a virtual workshop to convene government officials and industry experts to discuss current and projected UAS technologies. The workshop will focus on transporting cargo of various sizes for delivery between island economies. Participants will learn of advances used to deliver medical payloads, food and other goods using UAS of various sizes, ranges and payload capacities. They will also discuss the future of UAS delivery systems.

### BACKGROUND

Technological UAS advancements offer new cost-effective tools to fill gaps related to health and emergency supply chains, especially in serving remote, sparsely populated or otherwise underserved communities. New UAS technology can deliver small cargo like vaccines and medical products, or larger payloads like critical humanitarian aid.

The U.S. - Southeast Asia Aviation Cooperation Program (SEA ACP) is a public-private partnership that works with Southeast Asian and Pacific Island aviation stakeholders to design programs that promote technical, policy and commercial cooperation in civil aviation. SEA ACP is industry led and supported by USTDA and other U.S. federal agencies.

The SEA ACP:

- Provides a cooperative framework for government interaction between Southeast Asian and Pacific Island countries and the United States.
- Promotes a safe and secure airspace through training on international standards and aviation best practices.
- Enables local governments and local industry to engage with U.S. companies to learn best practices and gain critical aviation expertise.

Program activities match the needs of partner countries with the technical innovation of U.S. member companies.
